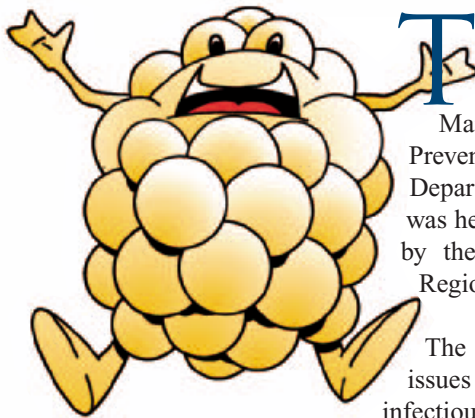

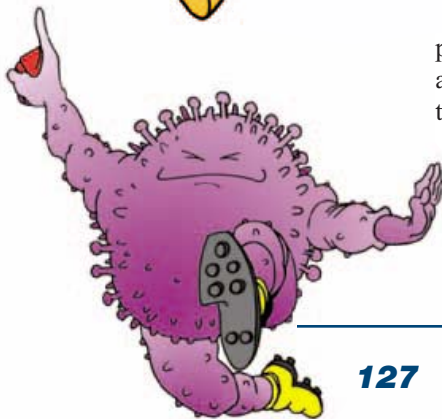
# Superbugs
